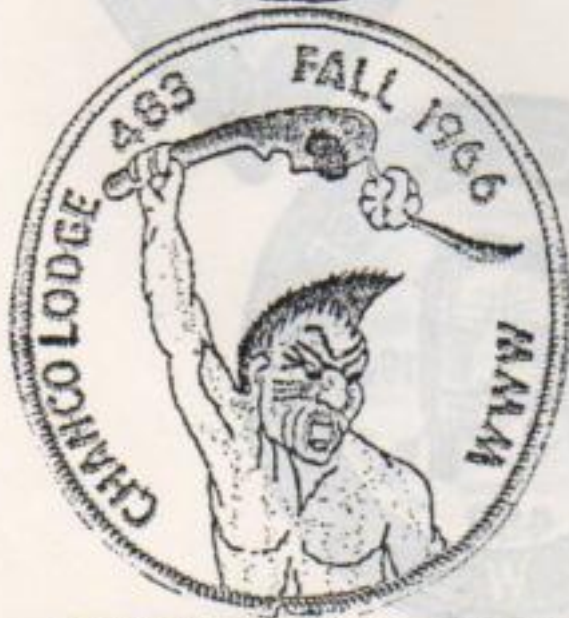

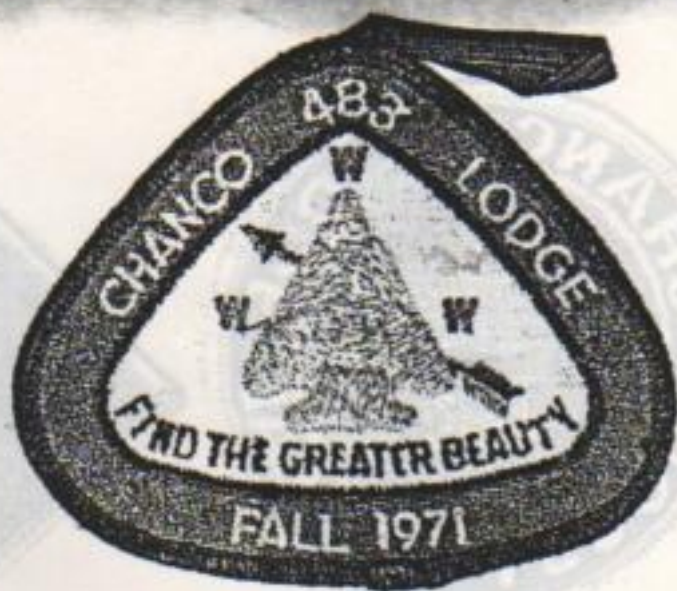

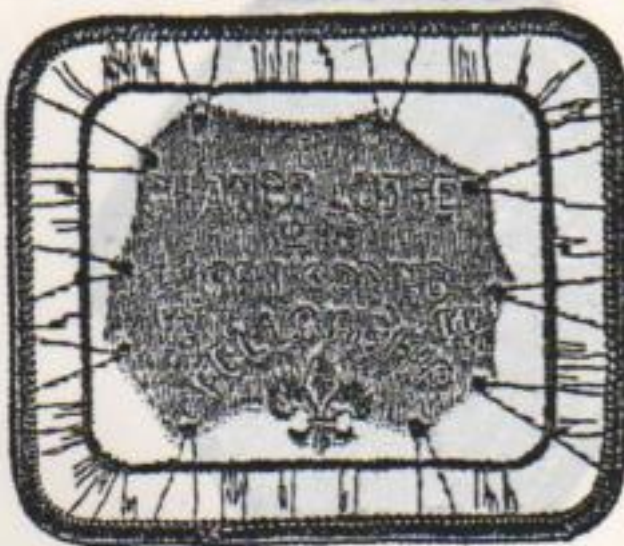

## Historic Set Patch Explanation

After Powhatan died, his brother Opechancanough (Ope-can-canoe) became chief. He promised that his thirty tribes would be peaceful. He said the sky would fall before he would break the peace.

The settlers began to trust the Indians. The settlers thought it safe to start little settlements up and down the James River. Settlers traded with the Indians. They lent them their boats. They played games with them. Some Indian children even lived with the settlers.

Chanco was an Indian boy who lived with the Pace family. He loved this family and he became a Christian.

Then one day in 1622, Opechancanough told his tribes to rid the land of all the settlers. He gave an order. He said that all settlements would be attacked at the same time. All settlements would be attacked after sunrise the next morning.

Chanco had an older brother who still lived with his tribe. So it was this brother who was sent to give Chanco the message to attack. Chanco's brother told the young Indian to kill the Pace family. He reminded Chanco of how the settlers had taken the Indians' land from them. He told his young brother that the <sup>day</sup> was depending upon Chanco to help his people. But Chanco felt as if the Pace family were his people too. We all know what followed.

Spring Patch is Chanco being told of the chiefs order by his older brother. Chanco would have had his hair cut because he was a Christian and living with the Pace family. The time of the patch is sunset the day before the massacre.

Fall Patch is Chanco telling Mr. Pace of the massacre coming the following day. They are sitting at the dining room table. The time is night (the moon is seen in the window). The chandelier has a light glow around it. (The WNW and Fleurdelis are in the chandelier). Mr. Pace is making a fist on the table because he knows that he will have to do something to try to stop the massacre.

Christmas Banquet Patch is Mr. Pace after rowing across the James River four miles at night warning the Jamestown settlement. The patch shows the row boat on the river bank, the fort, a moonlit night, Mr. Pace coming to the Fort carrying a torch and being met by colonist from the fort, also carrying torches. Jamestown colonists were prepared for the surprise attack the following morning. The rest is history.
