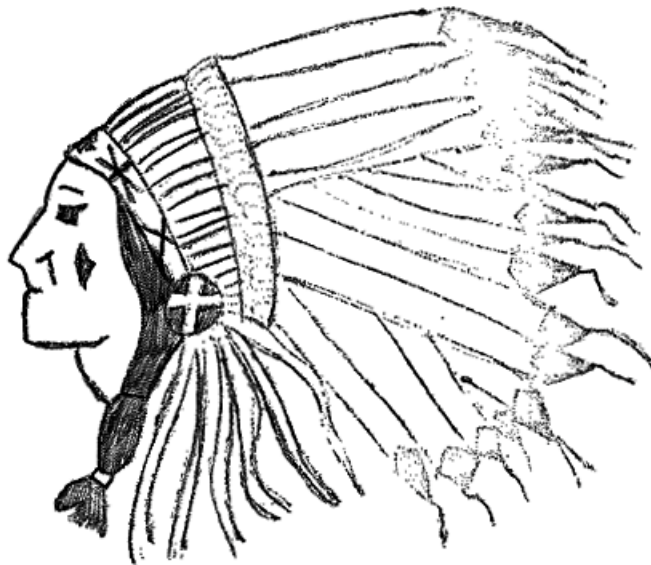

There will be an Executive Committee Meeting April 5, 1974, at 10:00 p.m. at Siouan Scout Reservation. This is Friday Night of the Spring Fellowship.

Patch Auction

There will be a Patch Auction Saturday night. The proceeds will go in the Lodge Treasury and the Executive Committee will decide what to do with it. Please bring all your patches and money so we will have a big Patch Auction. (Saturday Night, April 6.)

The Bylaws Committee of Chanco Lodge do hereby abolish all Bylaws governing Chanco Lodge #483 and that the membership be guided by the Official Bylaws found in the Order of the Arrow Handbook. Further information not found in OA Handbook applicable to Chanco Lodge shall be covered in a Policy Guide. The Policy Guides are as follows: INTRODUCTION!!

All items listed as policy are not to be considered as laws but as items to be adjusted according to need of the policy. The Executive Committee should review these needs and adjust them whenever necessary. No policy item should be binding on any incoming administration.

All items of law or rules are indexed in the National OA Handbook.

CHANCO LODGE POLICY GUIDE

- I. This body shall be known as the Chanco Lodge No. 483, Order of the Arrow W.W.W., an affiliate of the National Boy Scouts of America and the Old Dominion Area Council, Suffolk, Va., consisting of the Eastern, Central, and Western Districts.
- II. The Lodge Treasurer shall be responsible for all Lodge materials and the ordering of all Lodge materials. He further shall keep up the patch collection.
- III. The annual business meeting shall be held during August to elect officers and to conduct all necessary business. Newly elected officers assume their duties at the close of the August meeting.
- IV. The Executive Committee will meet at least six times a year on a schedule set forth by them.
- V. Membership dues shall be \$2.00 per year per member to be paid by December 31 for the following year. A \$1.00 penalty will be charged after that date.
- VI. Ordeal members shall receive one flap at entering and no more until reaching Brotherhood.
- VII. Brotherhood and Vigil members will be able to buy two flaps per year.
- VIII. The Conclave delegation will consist of six (6) places for the Lodge officers (Chief, Lay and Prof. Advisor, Asst. Advisor, Secretary, and Treasurer). Places will be next taken from the number for use of the dancers who will attend the Conclave. The rest of the number will be from the three districts.
- IX. The delegation going to the National Conference will be on a first come first served basis after notice has been given.
- X. One neckerchief a life time. You can replace your Lodge neckerchief by turning in the tarnished neckerchief patch with regular payment for a new one.
- XI. The Lodge patch collection remains on permanent display at the Scout Service Center except during official Lodge functions.
