chicken. Please circle this date on your calendar. See you there!

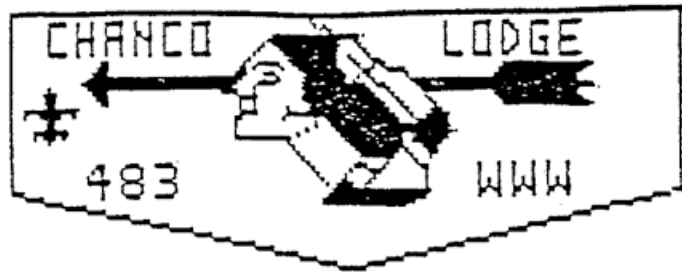
ATTENTION! JOBS WANTED

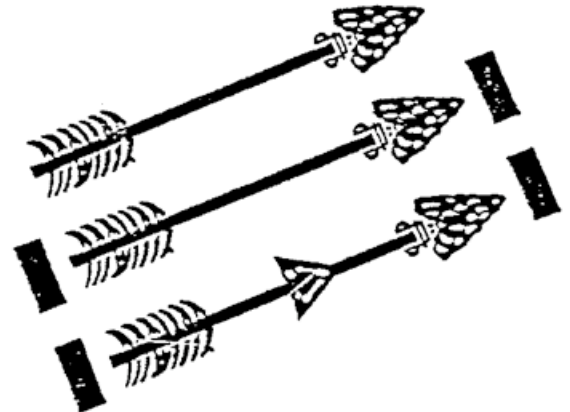


WORDS FROM THE CHIEF
