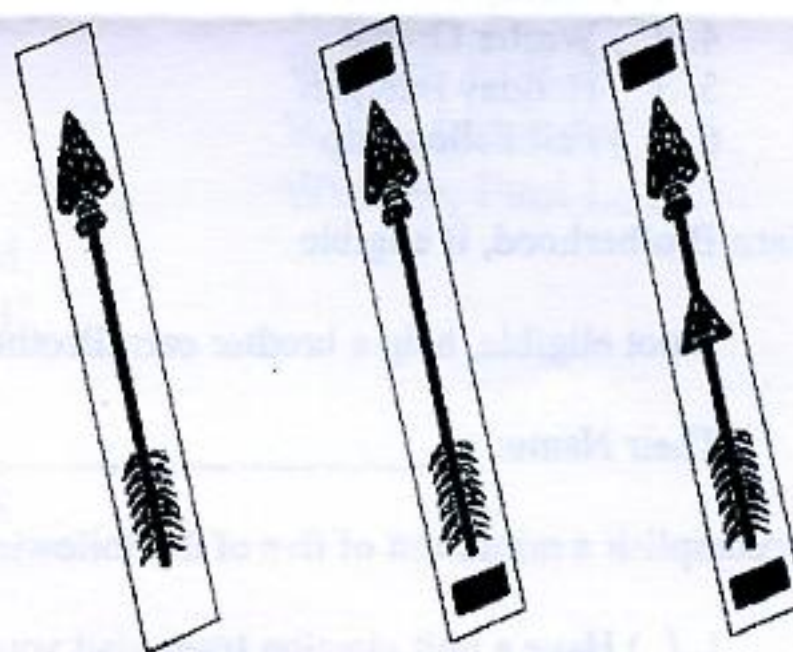

There will be no Ordeal or Brotherhood ceremonies during this Fellowship. **Members of the Blue Heron Lodge of the Tidewater Council will purchase and cook the food for the weekend. Therefore, no one will be able to attend if they do not register by the deadlines listed below. Do not come to the Fellowship unless you have pre-registered.** Everyone who attends must individually register. Group payments by a unit are acceptable provided a completed registration form for each person is attached to the payment. Summer camp tents are not available so bring your own tent.
