From Peninsula: Take Route 17 South across James River Bridge. Turn right on Route 32/258 (Brewers Neck Road) and go to Bennis Church. Turn right at Bennis Church on Route 10 (Bennis Church Blvd.) and go to Smithfield. Turn right on Route 10 business (South Church Street) and continue into Smithfield. Go to Battery Park Road and turn right. Go to John Rolfe Drive and turn left. Go to Lumar Drive and turn left. Smithfield Baptist Church is on right approximately 100 yards.

From Suffolk: Follow directions from Peninsula after reaching Bennis Church.

From Surry: Take Route 10 to Route 258 intersection. Turn left on Route 258 business (Main Street in Smithfield). Go to Route 10 (business) and turn right. Continue on Route 10 business and cross bridge at Smithfield Station restaurant. Go to Red Point Drive and turn left. Go to Lumar Drive and turn right. Smithfield Baptist in on left approximately 1/2 mile.

From Franklin: Go North on Route 258 to Smithfield until Route 258 turns into Main Street. Go to Route 10 (business) and turn right. Continue on Route 10 business and cross bridge at Smithfield Station restaurant. Go to Red Point Drive and turn left. Go to Lumar Drive and turn right. Smithfield Baptist in on left approximately 1/2 mile.

Deadline for registration is November 24, 2001.

No walk-ins or telephone registration will be accepted.

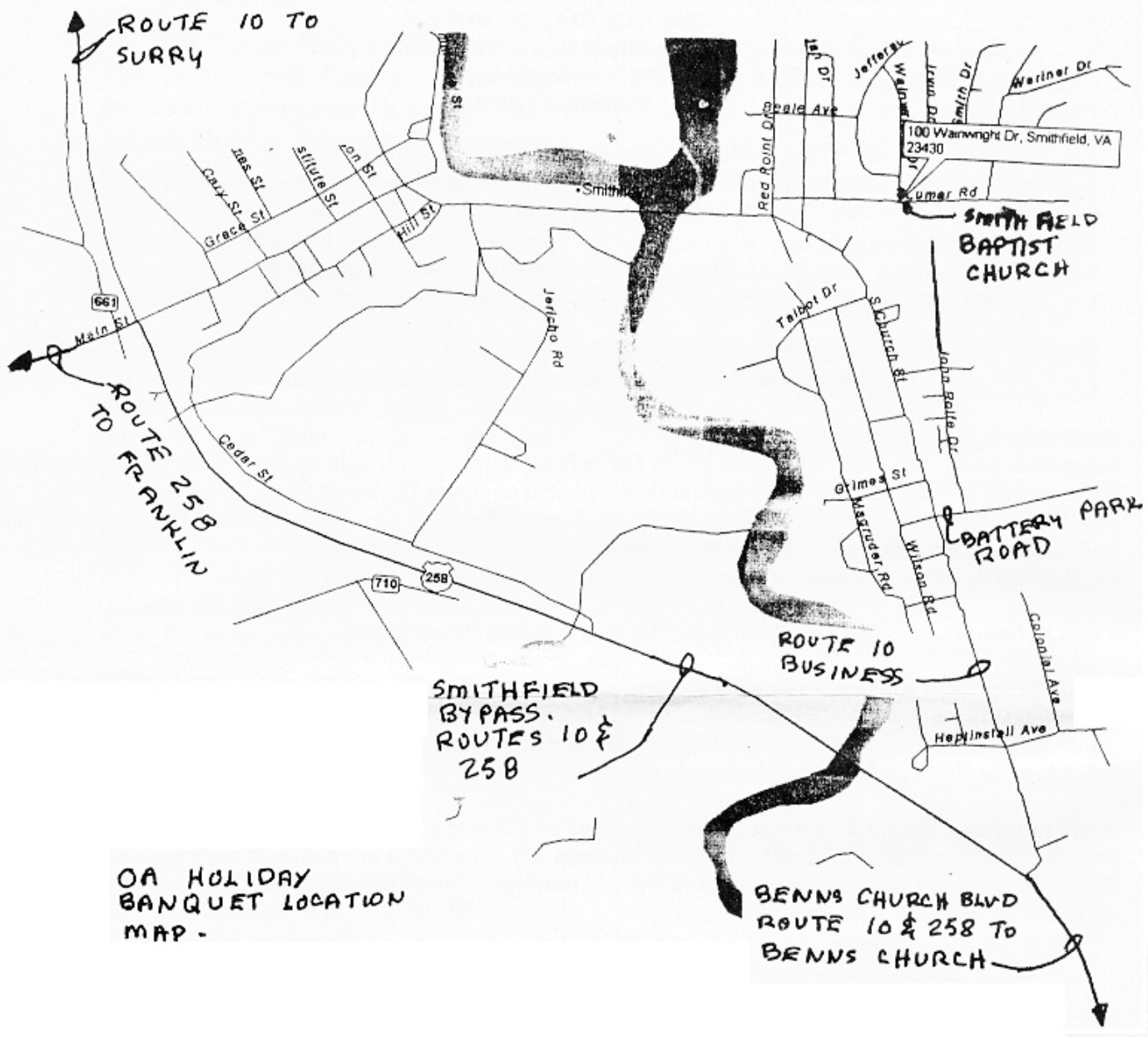

2002 National Order of the Arrow Conference

The 2002 National Order of the Arrow Conference is scheduled for July 27th through the August 1st, 2002 at the University of Indiana, Bloomington, In. The national fee has not yet been announced. Even though the fees have not yet been set it is time to get your name in the hat to go. It is expected that the total registration (National Fee + Lodge Transportation) will be in the neighborhood of \$400 for youth, and \$435 for adults (however this is contingent on what the National fee will be as well as van rentals).

Since we have not received any information, we do not know what registration restrictions will be placed on us other than that a 2:1 ratio of youth to adults, will be enforced.

To secure a place in the Lodge Contingent, fill out the information below, and submit to the Council Office No Later Than Saturday, December 31, 2001 with a \$100.00 deposit. Registrations will be taken on a first come, first served basis (two categories, < 21 and >21). If for any reason, we have to make a cut on participants, the deposit will be fully refunded. If for any reason you have to drop out once the initial registration has been sent to National, then deposits and fees will be refunded if a replacement is found.

Final Registration Fee amounts, and payment schedule will be forwarded to those submitting this reservation form as soon as the information is available. Act now, time will definitely slip up on you if you don't.

- This registration form is being sent to each lodge member in a special mailing. A copy of this form will be given to each new member as soon as possible after joining the lodge. Members are to make copies of this form as needed for their use. Copies are available on the lodge web page (www.cveboyscouts.org/oa). Copies will not be included in *Duck Calls* for the remainder of the year.
- Refunds will not be issued unless a written request is received at the Colonial Virginia Council service center by 5:00 PM on the Tuesday preceding the event. There will be no refunds issued if notification is received after that time and date.
- Everyone who attends must individually register and pay the event fee. Group payments by a unit are acceptable providing a completed registration form for each person is attached to the payment.
- 1 – Submit the Brotherhood fee only if you are an Ordeal member and have been for 10 months or longer, and you intend to seal your membership in the Order by obtaining Brotherhood.
- 2 – The deadline for regular registration is as shown. The "late fee" of \$5.00 goes into effect on the day after the "registration due date" and is in addition to the event fee. The "late fee" shall be included with each registration form that is not received at the Colonial Virginia Council service center by 5:00 PM on the "registration due date".
- 3 – No registrations, including late registrations will be accepted after 5:00 PM on the Wednesday before the start of the event. **Telephone registrations will not be accepted.**
- 4 – Uniforms are required for ceremonies, Saturday night dinner, and Sunday morning breakfast and business meetings.

Wahunsenakah Lodge has a dues structure of \$7.00 per year when the dues are paid on time (November 30 of the year preceding the year for which the dues are assessed). If the upper right hand corner does not have 2002 or later, you should pay 2002 Wahunsenakah Lodge dues by November 30, 2001.** An Arrowman who was previously a member of the Wahunsenakah Lodge and did not pay 2001 dues should pay the delinquent dues for 2001 (\$8.00) and the 2002 dues (additional \$7.00 if paid by November 30, 2001 or additional \$8.00 if paid after November 30, 2001) at the same time. **To be an Honor Member for the year 2001, you must pay your 2002 dues by November 30, 2001.**
